**ALL COMMON LIST APPLICATIONS ARE PRIORITY 1**

All Standard List applications received will be treated as P1.  
The reasons for this are as follows:

- The majority of Standard List applications received are P1
- These are items which are easy to reissue if not required
- Provision of a Standard List item early may mean that **accessible** does not have to provide a more expensive item later
- It is not cost effective to manage a waitlist for these items

There is still a requirement that clients meet the Access and Eligibility Criteria. For example, clients in aged residential care are not eligible for these items.  
This applies to **accessible**.

**EQUIPMENT APPLICATIONS UNDER \$37**

Applications for funding for equipment under \$37.00 require the following information:

1. Documentation regarding how the equipment meets the Ministry of Health Access and Eligibility Criteria (Essential to remain in the home / Mobility within the home)
2. A statement as to which of the following applies to the client:
  - In Residential Care (Under 65 years of age)
  - Receiving a Special Benefit from Work and Income
  - Unable to pay due to hardship. If this applies, how has hardship been determined, and what other options have been considered to fund the item.
  - Under 16 years old.

If this information is not provided with the equipment application, then the application will be declined. The usual process for requesting a review of decision will apply.  
Applies to Enable New Zealand and **accessible**.
